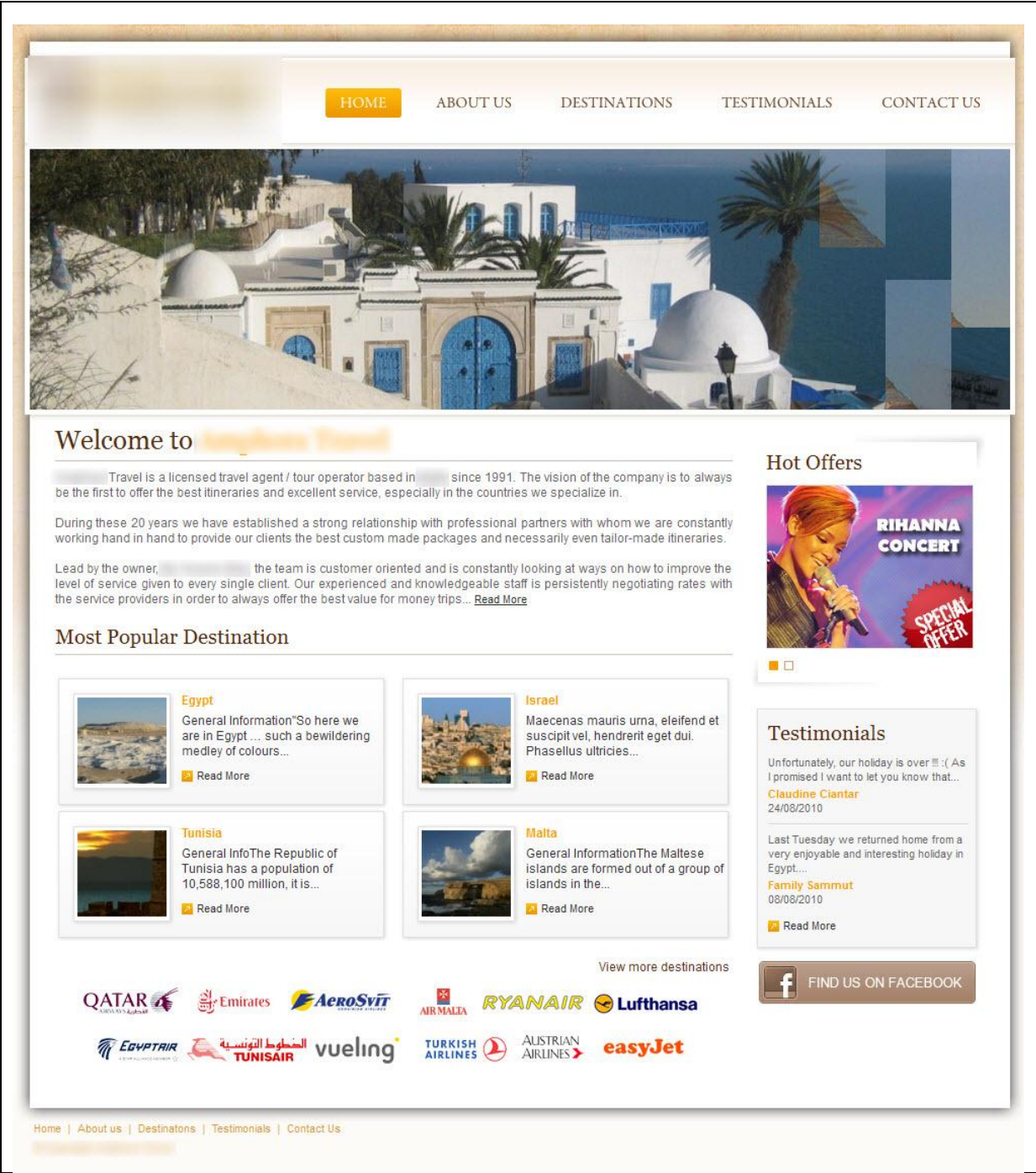





General Information

Egypt is the cradle of one of the world's greatest ancient civilizations and has a recorded history that dates from about 3200 BC. Egypt covers an area of about 1,010,000 square kilometers (390,000 sq mi) with large areas still uninhabited in the Sahara Desert. The majority of its estimated 79 million people live near the banks of the Nile River, in an area of about 40,000 square kilometers (15,000 sq mi), where the only arable land is found. Egypt represents one quarter of the population of the Arab world. The city of Cairo itself counts about 16,000,000 people.

The Egyptian population is composed of people from various origins. Most Egyptians originate from Ancient Egypt and the Nile Valley. Others come from the Arabic and Levantine descents and the Nubians of Upper Egypt. The History section covers Egypt from ancient times, including the Dynastic Period (3200 BC-343 BC), the Hellenistic Period (332 BC-30 BC), Roman and Byzantine Rule (30 BC-AD 638), the Caliphate and the Mamelukes (642-1517), Ottoman Domination (1517-1882), and British colonialism (1882-1952) as well as modern, independent Egypt (1952-).

Cairo

Cairo (Egypt) (Arabic Al Q?hira, meaning "the Victorious"), is the capital of Egypt and the largest city in Africa, covering an area of more than 453sq.km. Cairo is known locally as MIsr, the Arabic name for Egypt itself, because of its centrality in Egyptian life. Rising from the shimmering desert heat, Cairo is an intoxicating blend of cultures, history and peoples. Cairo is a relatively modern capital, founded in AD 969 by the Islamic Fatimid dynasty over the ruins of earlier Roman and Islamic settlements. Greater Cairo is spread across three of Egypt's administrative governorates: the east bank portion is located in Al Qaiyobiyah Governorate, while the west bank is part of the governorates of Al Jizah and Al Qaiyobiyah. Cairo also includes several river islands, which play an important role in the life of the city. The irrigation of Cairo's desert periphery has allowed for the development of suburbs, such as Heliopolis, located to the northeast. Other modern suburbs are interspersed with recently created migrant neighbourhoods that accommodate the city's growing population. Industrial areas further crowd the city, restricting its growth.

The center of downtown Cairo is Tahrir Square, located on the east bank. Cairo offers an incredible selection of shopping, leisure, culture and nightlife. Shopping ranges from the famous Khan el-Khalili souk, (or bazaar) largely unchanged since the 14th century, to modern air-conditioned centers displaying the latest fashions. Cairo is served by an international airport, situated approximately 24 km (about 15 mi) northeast of the city; the Ramses train station and a bus terminal located near Tahrir Square in downtown Cairo.
